

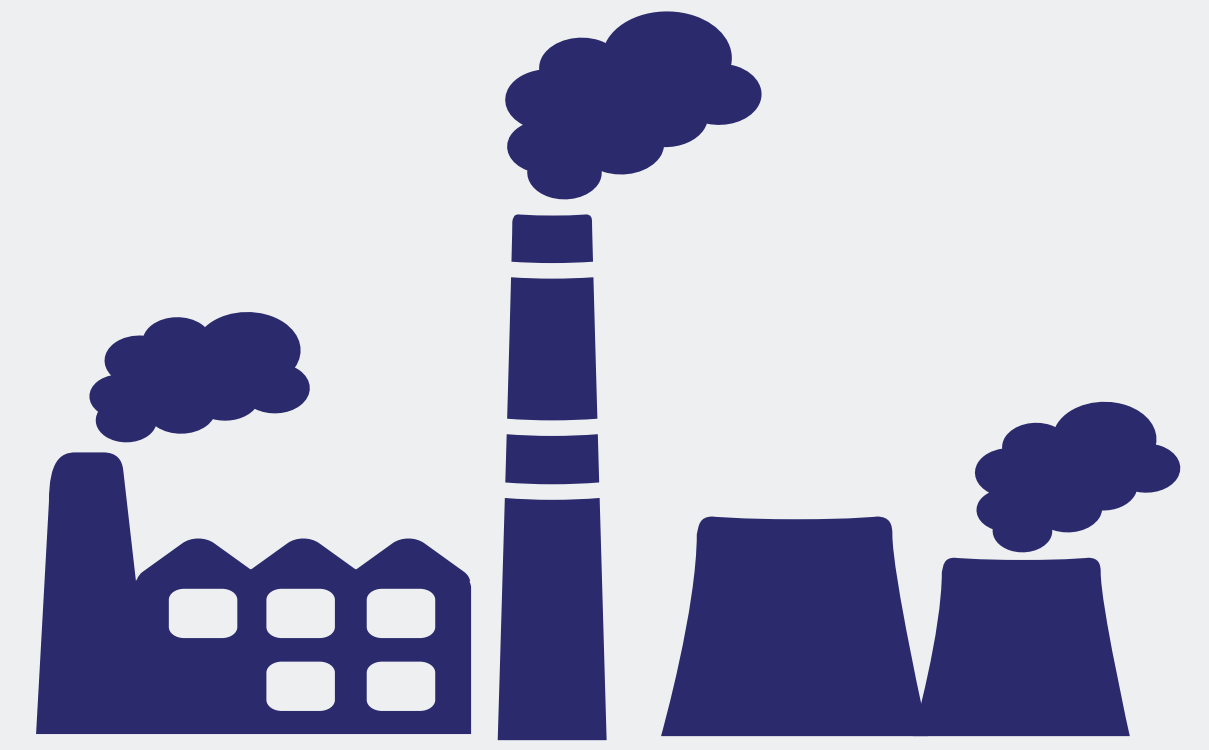

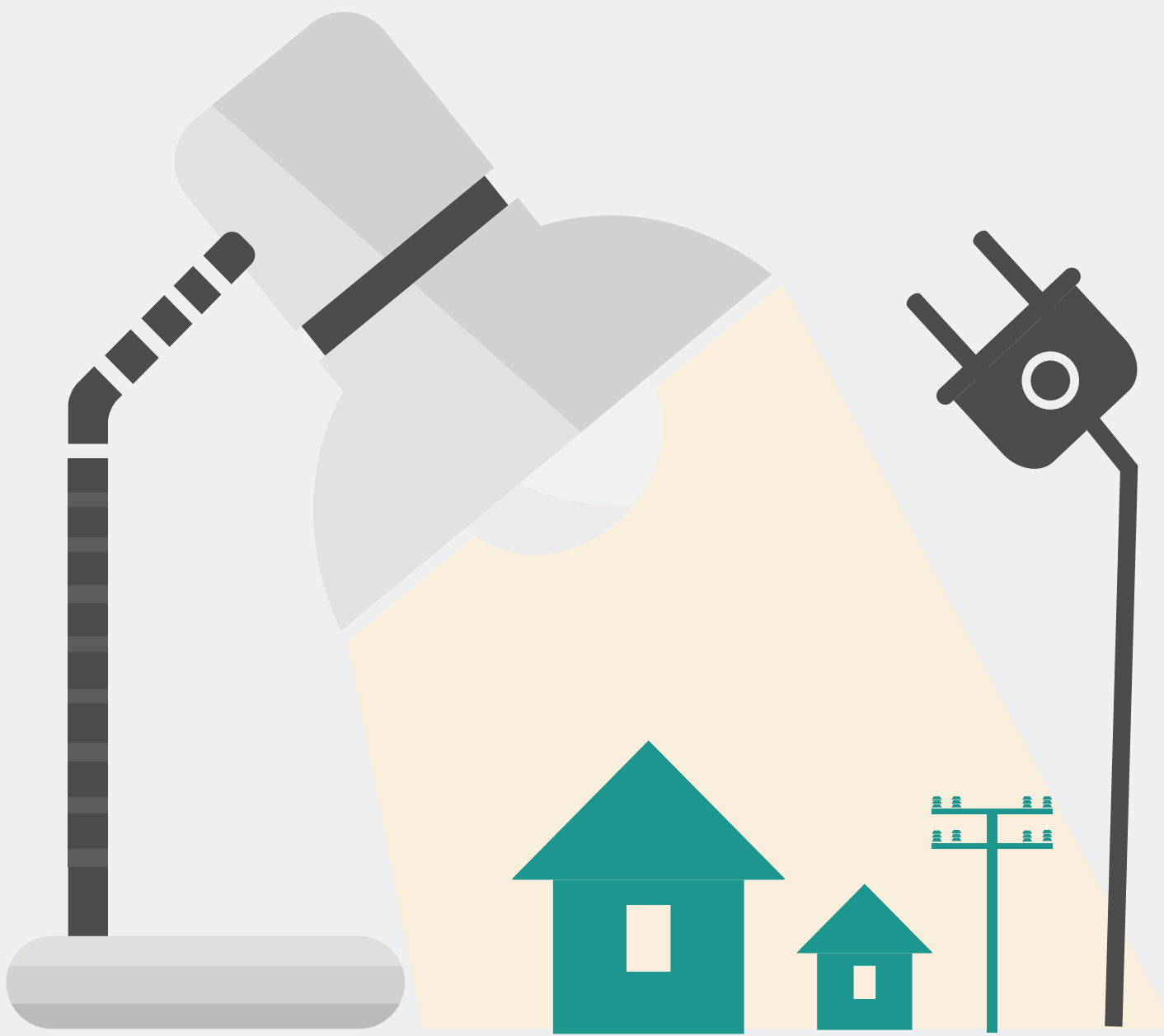

SENATE ENERGY TIMELINE

May 2011

Sens. Shaheen (D-N.H.) and Portman (R-Ohio) introduce a version of the Energy Savings and Industrial Competitiveness Act.

Feb. 2015

The Energy Efficiency Improvement Act of 2015 (S. 535) is introduced and in April 2015 is signed into law.

Sep. 2015

S. 2012 -- the Energy Policy Modernization Act of 2015 is introduced by Sens. Murkowski (R-Alaska) and Cantwell (D-Wash.).

Apr. 2016

Congress passes S. 2012 on April 20 including key energy efficiency amendments particularly the SAVE Act.
